

HOW TO CHECK FOR THE CAUSE OF A LEAK

Leaks and drips can occur for a number of reasons and can come from a number of areas on your Aquawave system. In order to identify where the leak is coming from there are a number of checks you can carry out yourself.

BULKHEADS AND PIPEWORK

Bulkheads are situated at the rear of each tank compartment on the customer facing side you have the black strainer at the rear you have the bulkhead. You need to check each of these for any leaks or drips. You also need to check all the pipe work connections to make sure they are sound.





FLOW RATES

If the flow rates are set too high on the taps in the tanks this can cause water to either spray or splash over the side. You need to check each of these individually to make sure this is not occurring.





PUMP CONNECTION AND UV STERILISER END CAPS

You need to check that both ends of the pipe coming from the pump in the sump are properly connected and the clips are tight.

It is possible that water could leak out of the end caps of the steriliser. Check around the outside of the steriliser for moisture.


IMPORTANT – <u>DO NOT</u> touch the unit with wet hands! Risk of electric shock!





DRAIN LINE AND MAINS LINE

The drain line and mains line run along the ground at the back of your system. The drain line is the thicker of the two pipes 1 inch, and the mains line is the thinner of the two pipes at 15mm. You need to check all joints and connections to make sure the pipes have not been knocked or stepped on causing the joins to split.





BALL COCK AND SPLASH GUARD

Your system is fitted with an automatic top up system, whenever water is taken out it is replaced with fresh water via the ball cock situated in the sump. As this operates under mains water pressure the inlet is fitted with a splash guard. You need to check that the splash guard is correctly positioned as in the picture below. You can test the splash guard by pushing the ball cock down gently.
